Taking Territory

*"Holy Spirit led us to a heavenly strategy,
bringing us back to basics."*

The Bridge for Peace Team trooped into the Temora Rural Museum. We passed an educational showcase that included a frilled neck lizard, the same creature I spied from the passenger seat in the fading sunlight as we traveled the dirt road into town. (How fortunate that Australian's drive on the left side of the road or I would have missed it!) The museum normally exhibited wildlife, ink drawings, and Australian bush paintings, but tonight the B4P team would showcase the Word of God, His love, and healing power. I would introduce our new book, *Spiritual Secrets About Suicide* and the team

would minister in the Name of Jesus Christ. This was new territory.

I had been praying for this night for months, wondering how it would unfold. The B4P team prepared with prayer on our host's farm. We sat with our Bibles and notebooks beneath the red flowering bottle-brush, eyed the sheep in the adjacent paddock, listened to the cheerful song of Willy Wagtails, and swatted at enormous flies buzzing about. As we waited, Holy Spirit led us to a heavenly strategy, bringing us back to basics.

is consistent. People are healed through Jesus Christ. He paid the price for us at His cross and offered us a new covenant through His shed blood. He promises salvation, healing, deliverance, and provision. He sent the Holy Spirit to us to equip us with overcoming power. The apostles needed it and we need it today. B4P offers people an opportunity to renew or enter into God's covenant, to repent, to forgive, and to receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit. As a team, we would continue to pray the B4P Covenant Prayer with those in need.

Ed said thoughtfully, “Each SSAS chapter ends with a prayer. Annette, why don’t you choose one, we can print it and each of us can have a copy for ministry tonight.” Thumbing through my SSAS copy, I chose the scriptural prayer at the end of Chapter Five, “Telling Secrets.” It sets people free of oppression, specifically addressing feelings of shame and the fear of bringing circumstances to the light.

The unity and love of the B4P team created an atmosphere that allowed the Holy Spirit to take complete control. God’s peace reigned.

A lady spoke with me privately about “something I never shared with anyone.” She wiped at a few silent tears as she spoke. Concluding our prayer time she said, “Before I came up to talk to you, I didn’t know how I would get the words out.” With a smile she continued, “But I can’t believe it! Really, it was so easy!” God gave the grace. B4P team noted a new ease to ministry and healing happened fast.

“When you talked about your passion to ‘Stop the Lies’, I realized I

had believed a lie.” This attendee was released from deception as she listened. “I thought the despair I felt was my cross and I had to carry it. I realized as you spoke that was a lie! I repented and was delivered, I felt the oppression lift before I came forward for prayer.”

A young woman felt a dark spirit reveal its presence as I spoke. She had experienced some difficult manifestations before that sometimes accompany deliverance. However, receiving prayer at the SSAS night, she was free immediately with no drama.

An aboriginal lady heard of our SSAS book and requested that I mention the topic when we ministered at her church. She had lost a grandson through suicide and felt many young people in her Aboriginal community were vulnerable. After prayer she hugged me tightly and said, “Thank you for writing this and helping us.”

Our rough and ready country host came in from farm chores and sat at the table. The topic of the B4P meeting arose and he said, “I know ten blokes who will most likely kill themselves at harvest time, because

crops are failing.” The team saw tears in his eyes. The B4P team responded, ready to go to the farmhouses and give the SSAS book and DVD to these men. But we were told, “It’s just not done, you will be met with suspicion.”

We decided to ask key people who have influence with the farmers if they would take free copies of SSAS books and our 2 hour DVD for distribution. B4P members also sponsored books to be given to farmer’s wives. B4P provided the DVD’s for free. We are discussing sponsoring a breakfast for the wives where B4P can minister to them and distribute books and DVDs. A pastor’s council member spoke to his colleagues about an outreach using SSAS and had a favorable response. A massage therapist in town whose son died of suicide placed a copy of SSAS in her waiting room.

Before Ed and I left New York, the team listened as Kevin read an email sent about SSAS. He wrote, “Suicide is a territory that the devil is having a field day with.” B4P is taking the territory, bringing healing to the nations through Jesus Christ.

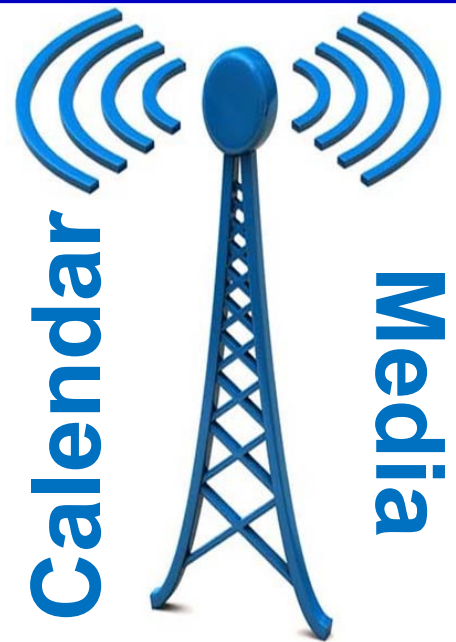
