### **Steeds of Fire**

"How will we melt hearts if we are not God's fire?"

"B4P will no longer ride horses of flesh, but steeds of fire," I heard the Lord say. I saw in my spiritual vision powerful flaming horses emerge from the River of Life. "Impact the world with the fire of My love. Ride the passionate love birthed through our relationship that causes B4P to love others in My name. Love carries you into the fray of the battle for souls, into the chaos of this world."

Horses of flesh indicate stubborn areas that we try to rein in. We have tried to ride our flesh and control ourselves through human means when the problem is supernatural. Jesus Christ does what we cannot do for ourselves. Christ immerses us in resurrection grace and we emerge forgiven, free, and with deeper love for Jesus. Christ transforms us and we no longer ride horses of flesh, but charge forward on flames of love.

Where God is not known, darkness rules through bedlam and despair. "Give us peace!" people cry demanding treaties, disarmament, cease fires. But deceitful hearts scheme to turn negotiations to their own advantage. Hearts without God don't want peace, they

want power and domination.

God calls B4P into chaos to heal nations. God sends B4P not to crack open hardened hearts, but to melt stony hearts. Intense heat liquefies rock, God's extreme love melts hearts.

How will we melt hearts if we are not God's fire? With this question in mind B4P discerned our Australian team name to be "Steeds of Fire." We refuse to be ruled by human cravings. Baptized into Christ, we died with Him and rose with Him to serve Him in this

world. Our call is *Healing to the Nations* through Jesus Christ. B4P preaches the Gospel, teaches the Baptism of the Holy Spirit for the overcoming power of God, and lays our hands on the sick that through the authority of Christ they will be healed. We care for the orphaned through B4P Children's Village. B4P Raphael Surgical Mission Team is in Guyana at this moment performing free surgeries for people in need.

This September and October the Australian Mission Team rode "Steeds of Fire," the warhorses of God's love, into spiritual battle praying in the name of Jesus. While speeding down Burley Griffin Way and crossing through Stockandbingle, I recalled the Book of Job's description of the war horse. The Word says the majesty of the steed's snorting nostrils is terrible. He paws in the valley and exults in his strength. He goes out to meet weapons of war. He mocks fear and runs to devour the ground with fierceness. As often as the trumpet sounds he says, "Ha! Ha!" and he smells the battle from afar.

If God so images the steed, then how do we imagine the courage of the rider? I saw that courage displayed as the B4P team rushed forward to meet whatever need presented itself. The B4P Australia Team showed great heart and passion for Jesus in their ministry to the people.

The team ministered to people who were in faith crises. Through B4P ministry many rose up empowered, strengthened, and ready again to take their position in Christ. A leader sobbed, "I don't have the faith you have, Annette." I asked, "Who gave you your faith?" She was confused by my query, so I asked another question. "Didn't your faith come from Jesus?" "Well, yes." "Does He give an imperfect gift?" "No, He doesn't." "So, you have been given Christ's perfect gift, but the enemy of your soul has convinced you it isn't good enough. And you've agreed." Tears of relief flowed, then tears of joy. She had come for prayer with severe knee problems, so I asked, "How are your knees now? Try them out." She rocketed from the chair, her face registered astonishment, and we praised Jesus.

God healed fibromyalgia, cancerous tumors, and bowel disease. God delivered captives of suicide, witchcraft, and abuse. People from 8 to 86 years of age received Holy Spirit baptism. And little Maya, not quite three years old, had a deadly prognosis reversed.

Maya had been diagnosed with an extremely rare antibiotic resistant infection. Her dad, an emergency room nurse said, "The doctor says she only has one year to live."

With blond ringlets, pink cheeks, and sparkling blue eyes, I commented that Maya appeared to be a healthy bundle of energy.

"That's how this disease works. It hides and gains strength."

The site of infection had been lanced, the wound was still bandaged, the doctor said it would never heal. We prayed.

Next day, her dad called. "The doctor said, "It's an eleventh hour turn around." The next week, "The doctor can't explain it." Then, "The neck wound is almost all healed up, we don't think they'll even be a mark left."

B4P Steeds of Fire Team still burns to see Jesus Christ exalted and people freed. All glory to Jesus, Captain of the Heavenly Host.

### **A New Season**

We have been building up to this and now we have entered a new season.

On the night of September 15<sup>th</sup> our regular prayer group meeting was all about healing, boldness, prayer, and reaching out. This led so beautifully into a charismatic youth rally held on the following night. Another had stomach issues with a swollen stomach area and it immediately went down to normal size. Others shared of pain lessening or going completely. People just kept going up to the front to tell how God had done something so amazing for them in just a few minutes.

Later that same day we had a Healing Rally open to anyone that wanted to receive healing. The youth music ministry from the Friday night returned to lead us in anointed praise and worship. We couldn't help but be drawn into Jesus. Some of the newly trained and equipped people who attended the teaching session joined prayer teams

and prayed for anyone who wanted to receive healing. It was a beautiful night of healing of all sorts including physical and emotional.

At our next Thursday night prayer

meeting we heard about more healings that had taken place in that last week, and we got into small groups and prayed with each other. There were healings taking place right there, especially to do with pain relief. God even seemed to target the most skeptical and showed His power to bring healing even when the medical world could not. People are growing in confidence to pray with others boldly asking God to heal. Thanks be to God for the ministry of Bridge for Peace. May God's grace continue to flow

through you to bless many more thousands.

It's so amazing to see God meet people exactly where they are and bless them without having to earn it. God is so generous bringing victory, release, and love. What a good good Father we have.

Annette talked about the Foundation for Freedom course, and ended with Matthew 21: 2 "Go into the village and at once you will find a donkey tied. And bring it to Me...say, 'the Lord needs it.'"

Verse 6: "Then the disciples went and did as Jesus directed them."

Go into the village (go inside yourself) and see where it is tied—we can be tied to fear, unbelief, hopelessness. God is saying, "I want all of your will." The enemy says, "Why are you doing that? Who do you think you are?" Etc. Just reply, "The Lord has need of me." Any place where you are bound, in the name of Jesus I loose the shackles, because God has need of you! When we are craving it and say, "I want it," we are healed.
