Barangaroo and Beyond

"...a few favorite stories among the many from this year's mission."

The ferry bumps up against the dock at Barangaroo, our destination point. Sally and I navigate the gangplank and I shield my eyes from the glare as the sunshine bounces off choppy water stirred up by the wind in Darling Harbor. Flagpoles line the harbor, their banners snap and dance above us as we stroll past the aquarium and the restaurants with outdoor seating. We find a table in the Heron Fountain courtyard. Jets of water shoot skyward surrounded by four foot high statues of longlegged herons in graceful poses. We review the completed mission, praying and planning for 2018, while

Sally's husband Tim and my Ed tend to ministry decisions and administrative details in Sydney. We settle into our seats and shake our heads in wonder asking, "Can you believe the mission is over?" As we traveled throughout New South Wales, God glorified His Name! Here are just a few favorite stories among the many from this year's mission.

Temora - A woman arrives in a wheelchair after undergoing surgery on both her feet. She is able to transfer and shuffles very carefully to her seat. After prayer her pain is reduced. She walks, lifting her feet, and begins to dance—

kicking her feet out in front of her!

Wollongong - A young adult filled with anxiety and depression is ministered to and given a Bible Promise book. She texts Sally the next day. "I read the promises and slept with the book under my pillow. Sunday I went to church..." She hadn't been to church in a very long time.

On the farm - Our host shared he had been experiencing **terrible back pain**. A B4P member rose from her chair and said, "Let's pray

for you!" He replied, "The pain left when Ed shook hands with me."

Temora Rural Museum - A week later a woman testified. "You prayed for me for PTSD. I hadn't told you, but I had been diagnosed many years ago. On weekends when my daughters had to go to their father's place, I would be crying on the sofa. This time, I was not depressed and prayed for them."

Concord - A woman had been "bleeding from the bowel". She had undergone many medical tests. The cause had not been discovered and her doctors didn't know what to do next. We received a message a week later. The bleeding stopped the night she received prayer and had not recommenced.

Newcastle - A woman attended who had brought her infant child for prayer the year before. The child needed surgery on both hips. The day after prayer, she took her child to the surgeon and miraculously the little girl was fine and the surgery was cancelled.

Hope Seedling, Newcastle - A man came to the meeting to tell what had happened after prayer last year. His nearly two year old daughter had a dire prognosis, an antibiotic re-

sistant infection and a serious wound on her neck as a result of surgery, that the surgeon said would never heal. The solution to her problem was either to cut across her face, peeling her face back and removing the glands or use pharmaceuticals that could leave her deaf and at risk for cancers and other things. The girl's father was driving to a medical conference when he heard on the radio, "There's a New Yorker coming who has seen some great healings..."

He said, "God told me, 'Take her there.' I said to myself, *They either cut my daughter's face off, risk her going deaf or we go and see someone from the states*. So we went, and there was no pizzazz, fireworks, fancy lights or anything. We sat there and listened, Maya got prayed for and there was no amazing impartation. It was extremely anticlimactic. The next day I had a phone call from the doctor who said 'We just had a state conference about your daughter...'

"When I got home that night, I took the dressing off of my daughter. The wound had discharged a big amount of pus and the wound had started to close. The wound just miraculously closed. It was absolutely an incredible gift. We had a follow-up with the pediatric surgeon. He took

me into his back office and we opened up a couple of textbooks and he said, 'It could have been this...'
The girl's father said, "It couldn't have been that because we had an ultrasound and saw a liquefied lymph gland." So the surgeon said, 'Whatever it was, we can agree it was atypical.' My older daughter said to the surgeon, 'God always wins and the devil loses.' It was a miracle and we give all the glory to God."

B4P Praise Cruise on the Napean Belle followed by a Sausage Sizzle Under the Marquis - A lady with neck pain had to literally turn her head with her hands. She was healed by God's Word preached on the boat.

We have so many more testimonies to the power of God as we bring healing to the nations through Jesus Christ. Believe in His miracle working power for *your* life. Believe it and receive it!

SSAS is also designed for groups. In Australia, they watch the DVD and share on chapter questions in SSAS. We had a phone call from a group leader in Australia last week. "...she's been struggling a long time. She read SSAS and she is a changed person. Her mother also suffered from depression...she's giving it to her mother to read!" We are moved by the many reports of lives changed and hope SSAS groups will start in the USA.

Through SSAS we hope to save lives and save souls. We want SSAS and the accompanying DVD in the hands of everyone who needs it. We pray God will continue to open doors for B4P to minister this lifesaving message of hope through our amazing Lord, Jesus Christ.

A road in the wilderness is constructed, the fence is extended around the whole village grounds, the electric and water is brought near, a guardhouse is built and the walls of the B4P International Primary School have begun to be erected! Many of the children received new school uniforms, new shoes and school supplies, and head off to preschool. Other smaller children continue to grow and develop with the help of our housemothers and volunteers who spend endless hours loving, feeding, teaching and equipping them for life.

There are now 34 children living at the B4PCV along with six housemothers, three volunteers, two guards to keep them safe, and Peter and Stella who supervise and administrate the village. It doesn't stop there though, there are many other people both in Uganda and throughout the world who support and encourage the village with both prayer and finance. We've been touched so many times when we hear the stories of generosity and love: someone collecting coins in a jar at their store and then forwarding a check for thousands of dollars, or the children in a primary school who give a percentage of all the items bought at their little bookstore and send us a check for hundreds of dollars, or the building committee in Uganda who volunteer their time pledging at their meeting and contributing hundreds of dollars from their personal money for the village or the couple who sends a check for hundreds of dollars after their wedding in honor of all their guests. We are so blessed by the outpouring of love and generosity worldwide. However there continues to be needs for the B4PCV.

Missed it? Maybe Not

"I was just diagnosed..." she wrote. Karla ended the email with her cell number.

I telephoned her and she said, "A friend told me about the Bridge for Peace healing service last night, but I didn't know what that meant. Today she said it was amazing. I missed it."

Gratitude touched my heart as I remembered healings I had witnessed in Brentwood as Christ's power moved through people. Three Bridge for Peacers served while ushers directed people onto our lines. A lady came whose painful arm had been immobile for a month. In my mind's eye I recalled her astonished face as she raised her arm above her head after prayer. I saw two more people raise their arms on the other lines and thought *more shoulders healed!*

A man with back problems was healed and touched his toes without pain! People bent swiftly—up and down, up and down—on the other lines as well. All praised Jesus for their healing! A man threw his arms around my husband Ed in a bear hug after receiving Christ's healing.

Jesus releases joy!

One man deliberately waited until the end. Over six feet tall, black leather jacket, he looked like a pretty tough guy. "I have an anger problem," he said. He opened his phone and showed me a picture of his golden-haired four year old daughter. He constantly worried about how his problem affected her, but seemed unable to control himself. Pounding his chest with his fist he said "I have a raging anger in here all of the time. About everything." We spoke and prayed together. He repented and forgave. As he received, light filled his eyes, his face softened. God quenched the burning anger in his heart with the living water of the Holy Spirit. The transformational power of God was evident in his body language; tears ran down his face, he shook as Holy Spirit power went through him.

Karla said, "I have been trying to keep my spirits up since the diagnosis, so I went line dancing. I should have been at church. I missed it. Are you having another service soon?" I heard a man's voice saying something about...a latte?

"I'm sorry, Annette. I'm in Starbucks. I've never been in here in my life, but my cousin is in the hospital and she asked for a special coffee. I'm on my way to see her now."

"No problem," I said. "The Advent Shop in Massapequa is hosting a signing for my new book. Is that near you?"

"I live in the next town. I know the store!"

"Why don't you come and I can pray for you."

"I'll be there." The barista called her name as we worked out the logistics. We prayed together before we hung up.

On the day of the book signing, Jane accompanied me and my husband Ed. While driving to work two weeks before, Jane heard Pastor Rich interview me on Hope Radio. She immediately ordered my book *Spiritual Secrets About Suicide* and offered to

volunteer at B4P. Jane is a faith-filled woman and an office manager. We welcomed her onboard. Together, we got situated for the book signing and afternoon of ministry.

Karla approached our table. She introduced herself, read my book's cover, and burst into tears. She had no idea I had written a book to help both people struggling with depression, anxiety, and suicidal thoughts and their families.

"Last night, I took my teen-aged cousin to a psychiatric center!"

The cousin who asked for the latte, I thought.

The placement was far from the girl's home. Her mother requested a different facility. "Her mother told me that if she didn't accept immediate placement the authorities would call child protective services!" Karla was terribly distressed. "We drove her to the facility last night. It was dark, I had a bad feeling about the place. I felt terrible leaving her there. I couldn't sleep all night."

Jane said, "I work for a charitable organization that helps people in

rehab. I often speak to staff from that facility. I am always impressed by them."

"Really?" Karla asked.

"Yes. It is a good place."

We prayed for Karla and her family. We released healing, wisdom, and comfort. And help was available through SSAS.

Karla thought she missed it, but her openness to listen to her friend and respond with faith brought her a double portion. Though unfamiliar with healing prayer through Jesus Christ, when she heard of the good things God did, she reached out to be part of it. Karla made the effort to get to where she could receive something new from God. Because she took action, we saw God's beautiful plan unfold. Think you've missed it? Maybe not. Take a step of faith.


"You would have to ask your pastor." I replied.

When Ed and I returned to NY, an email invitation from Elsa's Mozambique pastor awaited us. He requested we teach and hold healing services in schools as well as church. The proposed dates coincided with our plans to fly to Africa.

Missions come together through a series of divine clues. A dream, a scripture, a persistent sense of invitation, signs that lead to discerning God's will. We cannot always send a B4P team, but we sensed God in the timing of this request. Because B4P has been bringing healing in the area of suicide, I checked Portuguese speaking Mozambique's position in worldwide statistics. It is number one for death by suicide in African nations. Exactly the people we want to reach. With continued prayer, Ed and I became convinced the Holy Spirit was sending us a memo: Mozambique 2018.

We'll be translated at school assemblies and hold a healing service in the school! Ed persisted in his quest for a Portuguese version of Founda-

tion for Healing. Volunteer Leia Eisenhower appeared and completed the translation. We can now present them with a B4P resource for future reference!

Elsa wrote, "The people are already celebrating in anticipation of your arrival." We're zipping our bags and on our way. Watch for B4P Facebook messages from Maputo, -Annette Mozambique!
